4 Recipients of data.

When you fill in a form on the website, the information is stored on the servers of hosting.nl or wix.com. The information is transferred to the computers of CFUP via secured connections, FTPS or email.

Emails addressed to CFUP arrive at the servers of hosting.nl or wix.com and eventually on the computers of CFUP.

When you buy a book of publisher CFUP via www.boekbestellen.nl, the data will end up partly on the computers of CFUP.

The CFUP website makes use of Google Analytics. You can find their privacy policy with more information on the websites of Google and Google Analytics.

5 Storage period.

Personal data are stored for as long as:

- it is required by law, such as invoices and accounting for the tax authorities
- it is necessary for the delivery of products or services

- reporting is desirable, such as newsletters

6 Your rights

6.1 Right to view:
